RHSTEP is a pioneer national non government organization focusing on Sexual and Reproductive Health Rights (SRHR) for more than three decades in Bangladesh.

RHSTEP was evolved in 1983 as a special project under the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW) of the Government of Bangladesh titled MRTSP. In 1989 MRTSP was transformed into a NGO. Considering the increasing need of other reproductive health care, MRTSP stepped forward in 2002 with multifaceted services and a new name 'Reproductive Health Services Training and Education Program - RHSTEP'.

RHSTEP has extended its activities centers in 20 districts of Bangladesh. Every year approximately 6,50,000 women, men including youth adolescents and children receives health care services, education and awareness support through our 28 centers.

RHSTEP is registered under Social Welfare

Registration Act, 1961 with the Department of Social Welfare, (Registration no - DHA - 02459, dated 05 August 1990); NGO Affairs Bureau of the Government of Bangladesh, (Registration no - 430, dated 09 January 1991).

# young people in focus

Young people constituted more than 32% of total population of Bangladesh. Adolescent reproductive health situation in Bangladesh has been recognized officially as 'unsatisfactory' both in terms of program efforts and actual performance. It has one of the highest rates of child marriage in the world. A national survey conducted by icddr, b and Plan International Bangladesh in 2013 reveals that 64% of women currently aged 20-24 were married before the age of 18. Child marriage is a violation of human rights. It especially affects girls, robbing them of their childhood. It adversely affects education, health and wellbeing of girls and perpetuates cycles of poverty. Child brides experience the detrimental physical, psychological and social consequences of child marriage. This is a global phenomenon and a grave cause for concern. In Bangladesh, the issues needing immediate attention, particularly for female adolescents, are gender discrimination, education, employment, marriage & dowry, and nutrition. Common factors identified through various researches and studies states that poor socio-economic conditions leading to no or less education of adolescents and their parents is a prime factor.

RHSTEP has been working with young people for more than two decades for promotion of their sexual and reproductive health & rights. Through the processes RHSTEP learnt and came out with many experiences. RHSTEP's adolescents themselves raised their voices and demanding to enforce legal processes to stop child marriage, implement birth registration, strengthen national child protection which is vital to helping to prevent and respond to child marriage, increase the awareness of families and communities, especially fathers, adolescents themselves should be engaged to prevent early marriage in their communities. They should aware of their rights and need to be supported to take action. RHSTEP 'Through the voices of Adolescents' also recommends investing in girls' education and adolescents' sexual & reproductive health.
